With a library card from Mohawk Community Library, patrons have access to the free resources available through Libby, the library reading app. Within the app, users are able to borrow ebooks, audiobooks, magazines and more free of cost! The materials available within the app span a variety of genres, consist of materials for readers of all ages, and include new titles that are added daily.

There are many benefits to using Libby. Patrons have access to Libby 24 hours a day. This means users never have to worry about running out of books to read, or not being able to get to the physical library during regular operating hours. Libby also allows patrons to access their materials when they are traveling by having the app downloaded on their device of choice. Materials are available in different languages. When using an ebook, the reader has the ability to adjust the print size to best fit their needs. Users can place holds on materials and suggest titles that they wish to have added to the digital library.

Whether you are looking for an ebook or magazine to read on your favorite device, wanting to listen to an audiobook while working out or cleaning, or just need a book for you or your child to read in a waiting room, Libby might be a great fit for you! 

Start the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten Program Today

Children who have not yet entered kindergarten are invited to register for the free 1000 Books Before Kindergarten Program at Mohawk Community Library. This program encourages adults to read 1000 books to a child with a goal of completion prior to the child starting their kindergarten year.

Upon registration, the library will provide tracking materials for each child participating. Patrons can check out library books to read to the child and count them toward this program. Prizes are awarded to children for every 100 books they read. Progress through the program is celebrated on a display within the library.

Parents, guardians, grandparents and caregivers are encouraged to work together to help children meet this educational goal! This program is a great way for adults to assist children in the development of early literacy skills while establishing a love for books and reading. Children are introduced to the library at an early age which allows them to get comfortable with using a resource that can be valuable to them throughout their lives. Additionally, the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten Program encourages bonding and connection between children and the adults in their lives.



STEP 1 INSTALL LIBBY

Install Libby on your device and follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with your library card.

STEP 2 BROWSE

Search and browse your library's collection. The digital library never closes, and you don't have to worry about fines or late fees!

STEP 3 BORROW

Make your choice and tap Borrow.

STEP 4 ENJOY

Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.
