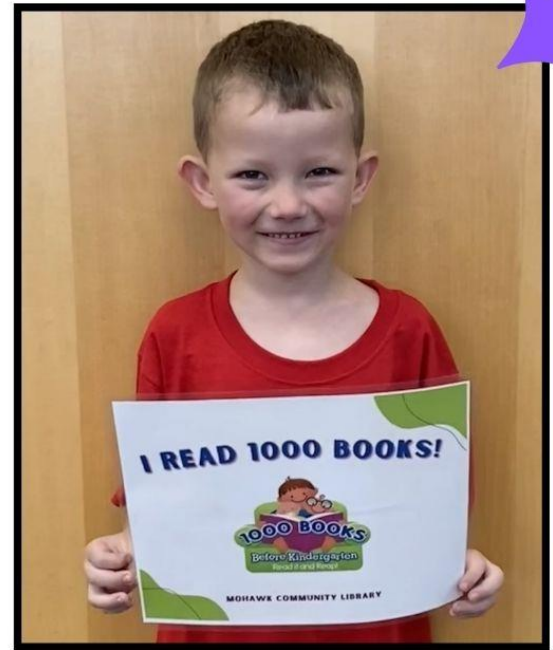
Each time you use your library card during the month of September, you may enter to win one of several prizes! First-time borrowers will receive additional entries at the time of sign-up!

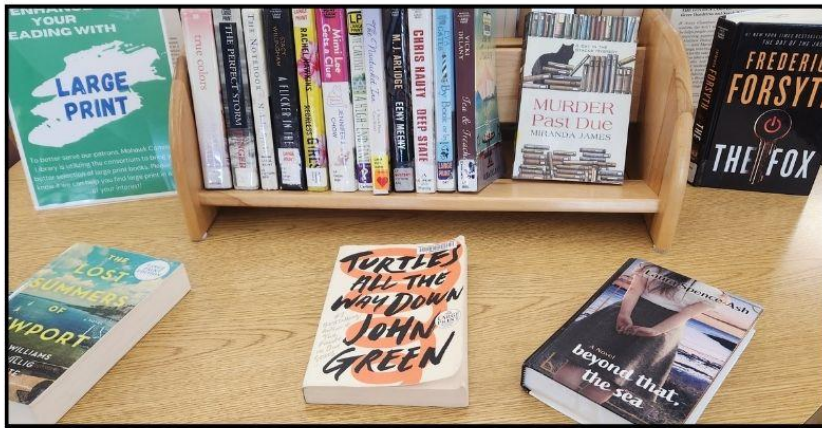
DUNGEONS & DRAGONS GUILD: MONTHLY GATHERING

Large Print Books Available for Library Patrons



Some book lovers may find themselves struggling to read standard size print in books. An Alternative reading option for those readers may be large print books. Large print books can reduce the strain to the reader's eyes, by offering a larger text as well as additional space between the lines of the book.

At Mohawk Community Library, we are hoping to provide individuals that struggle to read standard print additional options with the availability of large print books. On top of the large print books that circulate from our own collection, we also have a display of large print books that are regularly changing within the library. Some of the books on display will include a bookmark that directs readers to additional options within the same series of books as well as book bundles that include multiple related books.

Mohawk Community Library staff enjoy helping readers find books they love! If you do not find a book that you are looking for within our collection, or on our display, please let one of our staff members know. The library staff would be happy to assist patrons in looking up books to determine if they are available in large print and help place holds.
